Canada's Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) framework is a critical determinant of project viability, with major developments. From 2019 to early 2024, about 25% of federal reviews were terminated before a decision, often for feasibility concerns. Even among projects with significant adverse effects, 73% were approved only after substantial modifications to protect water, wildlife, and community interests.

You will be guided through each major stage of the EIA process, including project designation and triggers, screening and scoping, baseline studies for biophysical, socioeconomic, and health components, technical modelling, stakeholder and Indigenous preparation engagement, significance evaluation, and Environmental Impact Statements (EIS). The program also explores climate and GHG assessment requirements, frameworks, cumulative effects analysis, and resilience planning, key expectations for modern Canadian EIAs. You will also examine the legal duty to consult, the integration of Indigenous knowledge, co-development approaches, and shared decision-making protocols that shape environmental approvals.



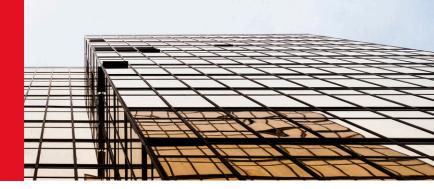
